The Yeates Volunteer Service Award recognizes individuals for continuous years of commitment and dedicated service to the TNSC. The award was created to honour and pay tribute to one of TNSC's great volunteer's, Shirley Yeates, whose tireless hours, energetic leadership and exceptional commitment have not only greatly contributed to a vibrant and successful TNSC , are not only the lifeline of the TNSC but also serve as an example of what great volunteerism looks like and can accomplish.

The Yeates Volunteer Service Award will be a way for the TNSC to pay tribute to its volunteers and to acknowledge and thank those exceptional volunteers whose generous efforts ensure the growth and success of the TNSC.

Who is eligible?

Volunteers who have been active beyond simple membership.

Volunteers who have demonstrated exceptional commitment, service and cooperation.

Volunteers who have made an outstanding contribution to the TNSC through volunteer service.

Volunteers who have demonstrated a commitment of service to the TNSC for a period of at least twenty (20) years (not necessarily consecutive).

Recognition

Award recipients will be recognized at TNSC AGM, where they will receive a plaque and a gift.

Award recipients will also have their names added to a permanent plaque to remain on display in the chalet.

In addition, the award recipient is eligible to identify a family to receive a one year complimentary family membership to the TNSC in hopes of encouraging new membership to join and volunteer at the TNSC.

Selection

Nominees that meet all the criteria will be carefully reviewed by the TNSC Board to ensure they are deserving of recognition in keeping with the requirements of the award.

Deadline

Nomination forms will be accepted no later than February 28th of each year.
